

Circle of 5ths

This chart is called the **circle of 5ths**. The sharps are arranged from the top, moving clockwise. The flats are arranged from the top, moving counterclockwise.

There are fifteen Major keys, seven sharp keys, seven flat keys, and one key with no sharps or flats. Similarly, there are fifteen relative minor keys.

The keys at the bottom of the circle are called **enharmonic**. They each have **two** names.
